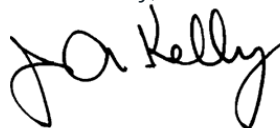

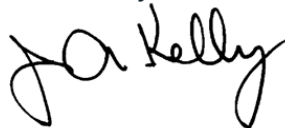

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INTRODUCTION

FISCAL YEAR 2025

The Comptroller of Maryland (COM) is responsible for collecting the alcoholic beverages and tobacco tax, and the Alcohol, Tobacco, and Cannabis Commission (ATCC) is responsible for regulation and enforcement of the State's alcoholic beverages and tobacco laws.

This annual report provides data and statistics related to both the tax collection function of the COM and the regulatory function of the ATCC. All information in this report, including but not limited to revenue, licensure, and other regulatory activities, are for fiscal year 2025 (July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025).

This report additionally contains the Annual Brewers' Report pursuant to the Brewery Modernization Act of 2019. The Annual Brewer's Report contains accumulated data from Maryland manufacturing license holders on their total beer production and total on-site consumption under an on-site consumption permit, a Class D beer license, or an equivalent license in the preceding fiscal year.

In accordance with the Alcoholic Beverages - Breweries, Wineries, and Distilleries - Direct Delivery Act, beginning fiscal year 2025, manufacturing license holders are also required to report information directly to the ATCC that includes the amount of alcoholic beverages produced under each license, the amount served for on-premises consumption, and the amount sold for off-premises consumption. Information reported by breweries to the ATCC is combined with the Annual Brewers' Report, information reported by distilleries and wineries is displayed separately by license class.

ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO EXCISE TAXES

The Maryland Alcoholic Beverages Tax is imposed at the following rates:

- ▶ **Distilled Spirits ≤ 100 proof:** \$1.50/gallon or 39.63 cents/liter
- ▶ **Wine:** \$0.40/gallon or 10.57 cents/liter
- ▶ **Beer, Hard Cider, Flavored Malt Beverages, and Mead:** \$0.09/gallon or 2.3778 cents/liter

If distilled spirits contain a percentage of alcohol greater than 100 proof, or 50% alcohol, an additional tax is assessed for each 1 proof over 100 proof at 1.5 cents for each gallon or 0.3963 cents for each liter.

Local jurisdictions are prohibited from imposing an alcohol tax. After paying refunds and the administrative costs of the COM, alcohol beverage taxes are distributed to the General Fund of the State.

The Maryland Tobacco Tax is imposed on cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (OTP). Other Tobacco Products include chewing tobacco, moist snuff, pipe tobacco, cigars, and roll-your-own tobacco. Local jurisdictions are prohibited from imposing a tobacco tax on cigarettes. From July 1, 2020, through March 13, 2021, the tobacco tax rate for cigarettes was \$2.00 on a 20-cigarette pack, an additional 10 cent tax on each cigarette in a package of more than 20 cigarettes, and a 10 cent tax on each cigarette in a package of free sample cigarettes. If the cigarette pack had 10 or fewer cigarettes, the tax was \$1.00 for each pack. Effective March 14, 2021, the tobacco tax rate for cigarettes increased to \$3.75 for each package of 20 cigarettes and 17.5 cents for each cigarette in a package

of more than 20 cigarettes. The tax rate increased again on July 1, 2024, to \$5.00 per package of 20 cigarettes and 25 cents per cigarette in a package of more than 20.

The tax rate for OTP and cigars is assessed as a percentage of the wholesale price, which means the price for which a wholesaler buys OTP or cigars, exclusive of any discount, trade allowance, rebate, or other reduction.

From July 1, 2020, through March 13, 2021, the tax rate for OTP was 30% of the wholesale price of the tobacco products. The tobacco tax rate for cigars was 70% of the wholesale price of the cigars and the tobacco tax rate for premium cigars was 15% of the wholesale price of the premium cigars. Effective March 14, 2021, the tax rate for OTP increased to 53% of the wholesale price of the products. The tobacco tax rate for cigars remained at 70% of the wholesale price of the cigars and the tobacco tax rate for premium cigars remained at 15% of the wholesale price of the premium cigars. The tobacco tax rate for pipe tobacco is 30% of the wholesale price of the pipe tobacco. For OTP, the tax rate increased July 1, 2024, to 60% of the wholesale price of the tobacco products.

Tobacco tax revenues are used to pay for refunds and the COM's administrative costs, with the balance distributed to the General Fund of the State.

REVENUE

Total net receipts from alcoholic beverages and tobacco licenses and permit fees, and miscellaneous income for fiscal year 2025 is \$500,178,162. Compared to fiscal year 2024, fiscal year 2025 Alcoholic Beverage Tax revenues indicate the following changes: a 7.99% increase in distilled

spirits revenue; a 19.96% increase in wine revenue; and an 8.87% increase in beer revenue.

The net receipts from the sales of cigarette tax stamps in the amount of \$390,443,546 reflects an 11.99% increase from fiscal year 2024. The net receipts from Other Tobacco Products tobacco tax is \$65,401,191, an increase of 6.08% compared to fiscal year 2024.

Cigarette taxes provided the largest percentage of net receipts at 78.06%, compared to alcoholic beverages tax revenues. As a percentage of net tax revenue, distilled spirits accounted for 5.04%, wine accounted for 1.42%, and beer accounted for 1.52%. Other tobacco products tax accounted for 13.08% of the total tax revenues and Tobacco Floor Tax accounted for 0.48%.

The State also collects revenue through licensing fees issued by State and Local authorities. The Alcohol, Tobacco, and Cannabis Commission (ATCC) issues alcoholic beverages manufacturer and wholesaler licenses, as well as various permits. Local liquor boards issue alcoholic beverages retail licenses. Cigarette manufacturer and wholesaler licenses are issued by the ATCC. The Clerks of the Court issue retail licenses to sell cigarettes, OTP, and Electronic Smoking Devices (ESD) to consumers.

The alcohol and tobacco license fees included in this report consist of cigarette manufacturer, cigarette wholesaler, other tobacco products manufacturer, and other tobacco products wholesaler licenses issued by the ATCC.

Alcohol and tobacco license fees are paid to the General Fund. Cigarette license fees are to be used to administer the law and enforce the Maryland Cigarette Sales Below Cost Act.

2025 Legislative Session

The following compilation summarizes the legislative text for alcohol, tobacco, and cannabis bills passed into law in the 2025 Legislative Session of the Maryland State Legislature. Note that this reference focuses on licensing and regulation of the commercial markets for these commodities, and does not contain all criminal, occupational, or public safety laws passed by the General Assembly related to alcohol, tobacco, or cannabis.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

STATEWIDE**SB1039****Alcoholic Beverages - Class 5 Breweries -
On-Premises Consumption**

This bill increases the ratio of barrels of beer a Class 5 brewery can bring in from an affiliated brewery to sell on-site by raising the affiliated beer on-premises sales limit from 25% to 35% of the total on-premises sales that year. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB544/HB599**Food Establishments - Portable Chemical Toilets**

This bill establishes that certain food establishments may provide a portable chemical toilet as a convenient lavatory if they conduct agritourism or are a Class 4 Limited Winery or Class 8 Farm Brewery. The portable toilet must be equipped with soap, water, towels or other approved hand-drying options; kept sanitary and properly ventilated; and located at least 25 feet from any well. **Effective Date: June 1, 2025.**

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

LOCAL BILLS**HB1108****Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Minimum Age for Employment of Underage Individuals**

This bill raises the minimum age for employees of alcoholic-beverage licensees from 16 to 18. If more than half of the revenue comes from food sales, the licensee may employ individuals ages 16-21. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB17/HB515**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Veterans' Organizations**

This bill establishes that a current Class C BWL license holder may apply to convert it to a Class C Veterans' Organization License. Applying to convert the license is considered a license renewal, not a new license. The annual license fee is reduced to \$300. Veterans' Organizations may also receive discounts on application and administrative fees from the board when they convert a Class C or apply for the license. Class C Veterans' Organization licensees may sell beer, wine, and liquor Monday through Sunday from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day, and are not required to obtain a separate Sunday license. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB568/HB409**Anne Arundel County - Board of Licenses Commissioners - Part-Time Deputy Chief Inspector - Compensation**

This bill increases the annual salary of the part-time deputy chief inspector from \$9,000 to \$18,000. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB571/HB99**Anne Arundel County - Class A (Off-Sale) and Class D (Off-Sale) Licenses - Population Ratio Quota**

This bill defines an "assessment district" as a district established by the County and appearing on the "Tax Assessment Districts, 2005" map. A mandatory licensing cap within these assessment districts prevents the Board from issuing a new Class A or Class D off-sale license if doing so would cause the license-to-population ratio to exceed

1:3,500 residents. This cap does not apply to licenses issued before July 1, 2025, to the 6th assessment district, or to Class 5 breweries applying for on-site consumption permits. The Board also may not approve a transfer of a Class A or Class D off-sale license outside its assessment district as of July 1, 2025, or, for licenses issued thereafter, outside the district of original issuance. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025, and expires on December 31, 2028, unless reauthorized.**

SB888/HB1259**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - License and Permit Distance Requirements**

This bill creates a new exception allowing the Board to issue a dancing permit to a Class H licensee if the premises is within 1,000 feet of a school at the Annapolis Mall. It also authorizes the Board to issue Class B on-sale beer and wine licenses, or Class B on-sale beer, wine, and liquor licenses, near a school at the Annapolis Mall. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB571**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C Licenses - Events**

This bill clarifies that each type of permanent Class C license in Anne Arundel County is intended to allow service of alcohol to members of the licensed organization and their guests of a member, but in some cases may allow service to other individuals during events. Other entities may hold events and serve alcohol on the licensed organization's premises, but must obtain their own Class C per-diem license. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1281**Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Limited Special Event Permit**

This bill establishes a Limited Special Event Permit that the Board may, at its discretion, issue to a holder of a Class B, Class BXL, Class C, Class D, or Class H license. This permit authorizes music, dancing, and other permissible forms of entertainment. The Board may not issue the permit to a Class BLX or Class H license holder if the premises are within 1,000 feet of a place

of worship or a school. Before issuing a permit, the Board may require the license holder to provide details about the planned event. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB284

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Hours of Operation Violations - Civil Penalties

This bill establishes that if a Baltimore City alcoholic beverages license holder operates outside permitted hours without an exemption for Class B restaurants and hotels, Class D BWL restaurants, or pharmacies in the 46th District, the Board shall impose a fine of at least \$1,000, suspend the license, or both for a first offense; and impose a fine between \$2,000 and \$20,000, suspend the license, or both for subsequent offenses. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB304/HB472

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - 45th Alcoholic Beverages District - Licenses

This bill establishes that a Class C Beer, Wine, and Liquor license may be issued on certain blocks with limitations, including a memorandum of understanding with the Greenmount West Community Association. Alcohol sales hours are set from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. for Class A and B-D-7 licensees in the Frankford neighborhood, and most licensees are prohibited from extending their hours before 9:00 a.m. or past 10:00 p.m. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB662/HB784

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Alterations

This bill authorizes the Board to waive the 40% food sales requirement for restaurants in the Fells Point area. The Board is authorized to approve a license expansion that meets requirements and has a second-use permit that references the primary location. Issuance or renewal of licenses may be conditional upon a memorandum of understanding with a community association. Certain licenses are considered unexpired for a specified time to allow for ownership transfers.

The most recent license holder remains liable for unpaid personal property taxes owed to Baltimore City or the State. Class B licenses issued under this section expire on June 30, 2030, and are nonrenewable. Only specified in SB662/CH814, a Class C license is allowed in certain areas in the 40th district with restrictions. **Effective Date: June 1, 2025, section 2 expires June 30, 2030, unless reauthorized.**

SB788/HB346

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - 43rd Alcoholic Beverages District - Class B-D-7 Licenses

This bill allows Class B-D-7 licenses to be issued in specified locations in the 43rd Alcoholic Beverages District, as long as the applicant meets certain criteria. A Class C license in this same area is considered unexpired until July 1, 2026. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB939/HB1172

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Authorizations and Revisions

This bill requires the Board to charge a fee for the expedited processing of Class C per diem licenses and to adopt regulations for the Class C per diem application. The Board is authorized to deny or revoke a license and limit the number of licenses issued. Certain Class C licenses may be issued in the 40th District with restrictions, including limiting sales hours from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., however, Class M-F licenses are exempt from these hours. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB1013

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - License Extension

This bill considers specific Class B-D-7 licenses in a certain area unexpired until July 1, 2026, to allow for ownership transfer and renewal at the same location. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025, expires automatically on July 31, 2026, unless reauthorized.**

LOCAL BILLS *Continued***HB746****Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Transfers**

This bill allows the Board to approve the transfer of a Class B or D license in existence on June 1, 2025, to another election district if approved between June 1, 2025, and May 31, 2028. The Board is limited to authorizing no more than five transfers of Class B or D licenses existing on June 1, 2025. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025**

HB987**Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class B-OB-CRD (Office Building - Commercial Revitalization District) Beer, Wine, and Liquor License**

This bill creates a Class B-OB-CRD Beer, Wine, and Liquor License, limited to one, for a restaurant with certain size and location requirements. The licensee may sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption and wine for off-premises consumption. Bar seating is limited to 25% of total seating. The license fee is equal to that of a Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor License. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1141**Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Change of Location**

This bill expands the circumstances under which the Board may approve a change of location for alcoholic beverages licenses. It adds a new condition allowing a move if the license was originally issued in the same election district and has remained at the same location for at least 10 years. **Effective Date: April 22, 2025.**

HB1145**Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Waiting Period After License Denial**

This bill establishes that if an alcohol license application is denied, no new application for the same location may be submitted for one year. After two denials for the same location, no license may be issued there for two years. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB910/HB1335**Caroline County - Alcoholic Beverages - Special Event Venue License and Multiple Event Licenses**

This bill creates a Special Event Venue Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a venue owner, valid for all events listed in the application and limited to one premises. The licensee is authorized to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption during hours set by county law for special event venues. The fees for this license are \$250 for 10 or fewer events per year, \$500 for 20 or fewer events per year, \$750 for 30 or fewer events per year, and \$1,000 for 40 or fewer events per year. Violation penalties include a \$100 fine for the first offense, and up to a \$500 fine and denial of future licenses for subsequent offenses. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025**

SB731/HB835**Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages - Baseball Stadium License - Alterations**

This bill authorizes a Class B-Stadium (baseball) Beer, Wine, and Liquor license holder to sell alcohol, and for patrons to consume alcohol, inside a county-owned baseball stadium, excluding parking areas, during games or events. Alcoholic beverages can no longer be served in styrofoam, however, other non-glass containers are now allowed. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB800/HB567**Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Arts Beer and Wine License**

This bill establishes an Arts Beer and Wine License for nonprofit or for-profit retail businesses primarily devoted to art in an approved area, not including businesses that sell mass-produced artistic products. Licensees are authorized to sell or serve beer and wine for on-premises consumption when snacks are served, Monday through Sunday, between 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. This license is not transferable to another location. The annual fee is \$250. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB802/HB564**Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages -**

Venue Beer, Wine, and Liquor License

This bill establishes a Venue Beer, Wine, and Liquor License to be issued to a nonprofit or for-profit retail business that hosts private or public events, with certain requirements. The licensee is authorized to sell or serve beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption with food, during approved hours. This license is not transferable to another location. The annual license fee is \$1,500. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB839/HB569

Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beer, Wine, and Liquor Tasting License

This bill authorizes the Board to issue a Beer, Wine, and Liquor Tasting (BWLTL) license to holders of a Class A license to serve tastings of beer, wine, and liquor, with restrictions on serving and amount. All opened liquor remaining at the end of the day must be properly disposed of. The license fee is \$150 for up to 15 tastings per year, or \$250 for up to 30 tastings per year. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB869/HB566

Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Fees

This bill increases annual fees for several alcoholic beverage license types and authorizes the Board to charge a nonrefundable application fee for new licenses. The application fee is \$150 for Class A, B, C, or D Beer and Wine license applications, and \$200 for Class A, B, C, or D Beer, Wine, and Liquor license applications. Renewals or transfers of licenses for the same premises are exempt from the application fee. The Board is also authorized to charge a \$50 fee for each license transfer. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB636/HB1026

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Tasting Permits

This bill renames the existing Beer and Wine Consumption (BWC) permit to the Beer and Wine Tasting (BWT) permit and authorizes holders to conduct on-premises tastings of beer and wine. The Beer, Wine, and Liquor Consumption (BWLC)

permit is also renamed as the Beer, Wine, and Liquor Tasting (BWLTL) permit and authorizes on-premises tastings of beer, wine, and liquor. For both permits, the Board regulates the quantity served to each individual and the number of containers used for serving. Tastings are limited to the licensed premises. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025**

SB670/HB866

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class C (Theater) Beer, Wine, and Liquor License

This bill establishes a Class C (Theater) Beer, Wine, and Liquor license for theaters with seating. The manager or a designated individual may sign the application. The license authorizes the sale and on-premises consumption of beer, wine, and liquor from one hour before to one hour after a regular performance, a fundraising performance benefiting the theater, or an event hosted by an outside group renting the theater. The annual fee is \$150. **Effective Date: June 1, 2025.**

SB738/HB512

Frederick County - Barbershop and Beauty Salon Beer and Wine License - Alterations

This bill increases the amount of wine that a Barbershop and a Beauty Salon Beer and Wine licensee may serve by the glass for on-premises consumption from 5 ounces to 6.5 ounces. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB826/HB685

Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages Act of 2025

This bill establishes a variety of new alcohol licenses for restaurants, resorts, festivals, and per diem service for beer, wine, and liquor combinations. Each license type includes application, location, and investment requirements. Restaurant and resort licenses are allowed to serve approved beverages for on-site or off-site consumption. Restaurant licenses also include a catering option. These licenses have a one-time issuance fee in addition to an annual fee. Class BDR-DC (Deluxe Complex Restaurant) Beer and Wine License: \$500 to \$710; Class BDR-DC (Deluxe Complex Restaurant) Beer, Wine, and Liquor License: \$2,250 to \$3,125; Class BRC-Resort Complex Beer and Wine License: \$700 to \$820 with \$410 fee

for additional facilities; Class BRC-Resort Complex Beer, Wine, and Liquor License: \$3,000 to \$3,500 with \$1,750 for additional facilities. Festival licenses require public hearings. Nonprofit organizations are now eligible for Class C licenses. Multiple-event licenses must have an approved alcohol awareness program on-site, and nonprofit licensees may cater functions on their premises. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB744/HB754**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Hearing Notice**

This bill changes the notice publication requirements for hearings before the Harford County Liquor Board. The Board may now publish its notices in either a local newspaper or on its website, rather than being required to do both. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB745/HB714**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Performing Arts Nonprofit Organization License - Record-Keeping Requirements**

This bill removes references to the Comptroller's Office. The ATCC and the Harford County Liquor Board are authorized to conduct inspections and review records of purchases and sales of alcoholic beverages by the holder of a Performing Arts Nonprofit Organization License. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB746/HB712**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Multiple Licenses - Golf Simulator Facilities**

This bill allows one Class GSF (Golf Simulator Facility) license to be issued to the holder of one or more Class B licenses. This license counts toward the total number of licenses issued to the same person. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB715**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Alteration of License Quota**

This bill raises the population threshold ratio from one license per 4,000 people to one license per 4,750 people for Class A, A-1, and A-2 off-sale licenses. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB1036/HB1387**Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class D Licenses - Delivery Ho. Co. 21-25**

This bill adds a Class D licensee or their employee to deliver alcoholic beverages within the county. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1494**Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class MT (Movie Theater) License**

This bill establishes a Class MT (Movie Theater) BWL license for movie theater owners with crowd control training certification. The licensee is allowed to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption to patrons. The Board is authorized to set sale hours, annual fees, and other conditions, and must adopt regulations for this license. The license may only be renewed as an MT license. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1095**Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Beauty Salon and Barbershop License**

This bill expands and renames the Beauty Salon Beer and Wine license to a Beauty Salon and Barbershop Beer, Wine, and Liquor license, issued to beauty salon and barbershop permit holders. Alcohol servings are limited to 12 oz of beer, 5 oz of wine, or 1.7 oz of liquor, and may only be served during regular business hours, no later than 9:00 p.m. Alcohol may be served during cosmetology or barbering services or during a fundraising event at the salon or barbershop with authorization. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1174**Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class BD-BWL Licenses - Multiple Licenses MC 18-25**

This bill limits a Class BD-BWL licensee to hold no more than two Class BD-BWL licenses. If a person holds two such licenses, the second establishment must have average daily food sales exceeding alcohol sales. Multiple Class BD-BWL licenses may be issued for the same premises or to an individual, partnership, corporation, unincorporated association, or LLC. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB476**St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class A License Quota**

This bill raises the population threshold for issuing a Class A license in the 8th election district to one license per 4,000 residents. The threshold for other election districts remains at one license per 1,350 residents. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB486**St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Civil Penalty for Sales Violations**

This bill raises the maximum civil penalty for alcoholic beverage license violations from \$1,000 to \$2,500. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB574**St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Multiple Licensing Plans**

This bill allows the Board to issue up to three Class B BWL Restaurant licenses to an individual or for use by a person, provided that each license is for a separate premises and only one license may include off-premises alcohol sales. Individuals are prohibited from having interest in more than three of these licenses, and can hold interest in only one Class B license that authorizes off-premises sales. Definitions for direct and indirect interest are included. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB1238**Somerset County - Alcoholic Beverages - Liquor Tasting License**

This bill establishes a liquor tasting license that the Board may issue to a Class A BWL license holder. The license allows free tastings if the licensee is authorized to sell the liquor and the consumer is not charged. Tastings are limited to 0.5 oz per offering and five offerings per individual per day. The license fee is \$20 for one day, \$200 for 26 days, \$300 for 52 days, and \$400 for 104 days within a licensing period. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB798/HB655**Wicomic County - Alcoholic Beverages - Temporary To-Go Event Permit and Class C Per Diem Municipal To-Go Beer, Wine, and Liquor License**

This bill establishes a Temporary To-Go Event Permit for Class B BWL licensees located near designated special event areas. The permit allows the sale of beer, wine, and liquor in approved to-go cups to be consumed within the special event area. The permit fee is \$20 per day. The bill also establishes a Class C Per Diem Municipal To-Go Beer, Wine, and Liquor License, which allows a municipality to designate a special event area for up to seven days where alcohol sold by a permit holder may be carried. The license fee is \$45 per day. The Board must adopt regulations for issuing and managing the permit and license. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

TOBACCO

STATEWIDE**SB0842****Electronic Smoking Devices - Seizure and Wholesaler Record-Keeping Requirements**

This bill prohibits ESD manufacturers from selling directly to consumers in Maryland under a manufacturer's license. ESD wholesaler distributors and importers are required to maintain detailed records, including an invoice for each ESD sale to a retailer that identifies the retail location's county. ESD wholesaler distributors and importers are required to conduct monthly inventory tracking and maintain accurate inventory records. All records must be kept for at least six years and are subject to review by the Executive Director and staff of the ATCC. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB664/HB577**Business Regulation - Enforcement for Miscellaneous State Business Licenses - Study**

This bill establishes a study to be conducted by the Comptroller's Office on how the Field Enforcement Bureau enforces miscellaneous business licenses under Title 17 of the Business Regulation Article, in consultation with various state agencies, including the ATCC. The study must be completed by December 1, 2025, and include information on enforcement processes, types of citations and their issuance, identification of license holders, and determination of responsible parties. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.** *Continue →*

CANNABIS

STATEWIDE**SB299/HB1347****Security Guards and Security Guard Employers - Registration, Certification, and Regulation**

This bill exempts a cannabis agent providing security services for cannabis licensees from undergoing a criminal history records check if they are already authorized by the State to provide security services. Video lottery operators, sports wagering facility licensees, and health care facilities are now explicitly excluded from the definition of security guard employers. **Effective Date: October 1, 2025.**

SB0214/HB0012**Cannabis - Sale and Distribution - Tetrahydrocannabinol Offenses**

This bill authorizes the ATCC to issue citations and seize non-compliant THC products that are sold without a license or fail to meet Cannabis product packaging requirements. Sellers of non-compliant THC products are subject to misdemeanor charges and fines of up to \$5,000 for the new offenses. The ATCC is now authorized to issue citations for the sale of Delta-8 or Delta-10 products to individuals under 21 in violation of MD Code, Criminal Law Article § 10-108. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

SB0215**Cannabis Reform - Revisions**

This bill defines cannabinoid beverages as single-serving products containing 5 mg of THC, produced by a licensed cannabis business and meeting established testing, packaging, and labeling standards. These beverages are excluded from the definition of food. The authorization for medical cannabis licensees to deliver is extended through July 1, 2026. On-site consumption licenses are removed from the second licensing round and reserved for future rounds of social equity applicants. These licenses allow single-serve cannabis products to be sold and consumed on the licensed premises, with operating hours set by the licensee's political subdivision. Licensees may acquire cannabis from another licensee, repackage it into single servings, and process it into single-serving products, subject to approval. Cultivation is not permitted. Dispensaries must acquire at least 25% of products from social equity licensees, as determined by the MCA. Political subdivisions had until July 1, 2025, to adopt ordinances to reduce distance requirements. Cannabis licensees are allowed to sell their business through an Employee Stock Ownership Plan prior to the expiration of the five-year transfer restriction. **Effective Date: July 1, 2025.**

HB619**Sales and Use Tax - Sales Between Cannabis Businesses and Cannabis Nurseries - Exemption**

This bill adds sales between a licensed cannabis business and a registered cannabis nursery to the list of sales exempt from the Cannabis sales and use tax. **Effective Date: July 11, 2025.**

- a. License fees are collected from manufacturers, wholesalers, railroads, steamboats, and airline companies.
- b. The distilled spirits and sparkling and fortified wine tax was created on December 5, 1933, at \$1.10 per wine gallon not over 100 proof. The tax on distilled spirits increased to \$1.25 per wine gallon on 100 proof or less on October 1, 1939, and increased to \$1.50 per wine gallon on 100 proof or less on July 1, 1955.
- c. The manufacturer's tax on distilled spirits began on April 1, 1936, at the rate of 5 cents per proof gallon. The rate decreased to 2 ½ cents per proof gallon on June 1, 1937, brandy and neutral spirits were exempt. This tax was repealed on September 30, 1939.
- d. Prior to April 1, 1935, the tax levied on sparkling and fortified wines was the same rate as distilled spirits at \$1.10 per gallon. However, as of May 17, 1935, all wines of whatever alcoholic content were taxed at a rate of 20 cents per gallon. The wine tax rate increased to 40 cents per gallon on July 1, 1972.
- e. The beer alcoholic beverages tax was created on April 1, 1936, at the rate of 2.4375 cents per gallon. The rate increased to 3 cents per gallon on October 1, 1938, and further increased to 9 cents per gallon on July 1, 1972.
- f. Certain permit fees were established June 1, 1943, at an annual fee of \$5.00 for each permit. As of June 1, 1959, permit fees of \$50.00 established for: Public Storage, Public Transportation, Public Storage and Transportation, Nonresident Dealer, Import-Export, and Bulk Transfer. Permit fees of \$25 established for: Individual Storage, Private Bulk Sales, and Non-Beverage (Commercial). Permit fees of \$2.00 established for: Change of Domicile, Individual Transportation, and Vehicle Identification Card per vehicle. No permit fee for Non-Beverage eleemosynary or Fuel-Alcohol. Solicitor's permit created on June 1, 1973 (\$50.00 fee); Wine Exhibition permit on July 1, 1985 (\$50.00 fee); and the Charity Wine Auction permit on July 1, 1986 (\$500.00 fee). Non-Resident Storage permits created July 1987 (\$500.00 fee). Alcohol Awareness Program permit created on July 1, 1989 (\$15.00 fee). Numerous license and permit fees increased effective May 1, 1992. Alcohol Awareness Instructor's permit created on October 1, 1994 (\$5.00 fee); Family Beer and Wine Facility permit on June 1, 1996 (\$400.00 fee); Private Bulk Sales permit on October 1, 1997 (\$25.00 fee); Winery Special Event permit on October 1, 2000 (\$25.00 fee). Direct Wine Seller's permit has been repealed, and replaced on July 1, 2011, by Direct Wine Shipper permit (\$200 fee) and Common Carrier permit (\$100 fee). Fee per vehicle for Vehicle Identification Card increased from \$2.00 to \$10.00 on June 1, 2003. Fee for a Charity Wine Auction permit reduced \$500.00 to \$10.00 on June 1, 2004. Nonresident Winery permit created on April 25, 2006 (\$50.00 fee). Brewery Special Event permit created on June 1, 2008 (\$25.00 fee). Resident Dealer permit created on July 1, 2009 (\$200 fee), and the fees for a Public Storage and Transportation permit, Nonresident Dealer's permit, and a Bulk Transfer permit increased to \$200. Direct Delivery permit created on July 1, 2024 (\$200 fee).
- g. Tobacco tax on cigarettes became effective July 1, 1958, at a rate of 3 cents per pack. Tax increased to 6 cents per pack on July 1, 1961; 10 cents per pack on June 1, 1975; 13 cents per pack on July 1, 1980; 16 cents per pack on June 1, 1991; 36 cents per pack on May 1, 1992; 66 cents per pack on July 1, 1999; \$1.00 per pack on June 1, 2002; \$2.00 per pack on January 1, 2008; \$3.75 per pack on March 14, 2021; and \$5.00 per pack and 25 cents per cigarette for packs of more than 20 on July 1, 2024. Prior to 1961, cigarette tax was imposed by certain counties and Baltimore City.
- h. Cigarette License Fee revenue is included in the cumulative total revenue beginning in FY24.
- i. Tobacco tax on Other Tobacco Products became effective on July 1, 2000, at a rate of 15% of the wholesale price. Tax increased to 30% of the wholesale price July 1, 2012; 53% of wholesale price March 14, 2021, and 60% of the wholesale price of the tobacco products July 1, 2024.
- j. Other Tobacco Products licenses became effective May 1, 2011. Annual OTP fees: In-State Manufacturers: \$25.00, all Wholesalers: \$250 (waived if have Cigarette Wholesaler license); Storage Warehouse: \$25.00. This total includes Electronic Smoking Device license fees beginning fiscal year 2024. ESD Wholesaler Importer: \$150, ESD Manufacturer: \$25, and ESD Wholesaler Distributor: \$150.

LICENSES & PERMITS

In June 2025, the ATCC implemented a new online services system available through the Maryland OneStop Portal. This new system allows users to apply for, renew, and securely submit payments for licenses and permits online, streamlining both the application process and the ATCC's fiscal accounting. This has made services more accessible for license and permit holders and has reduced the ATCC's operating costs related to printing and mailing certificates as well as the time spent on processing mailed in checks.

Direct Delivery Permit Summary

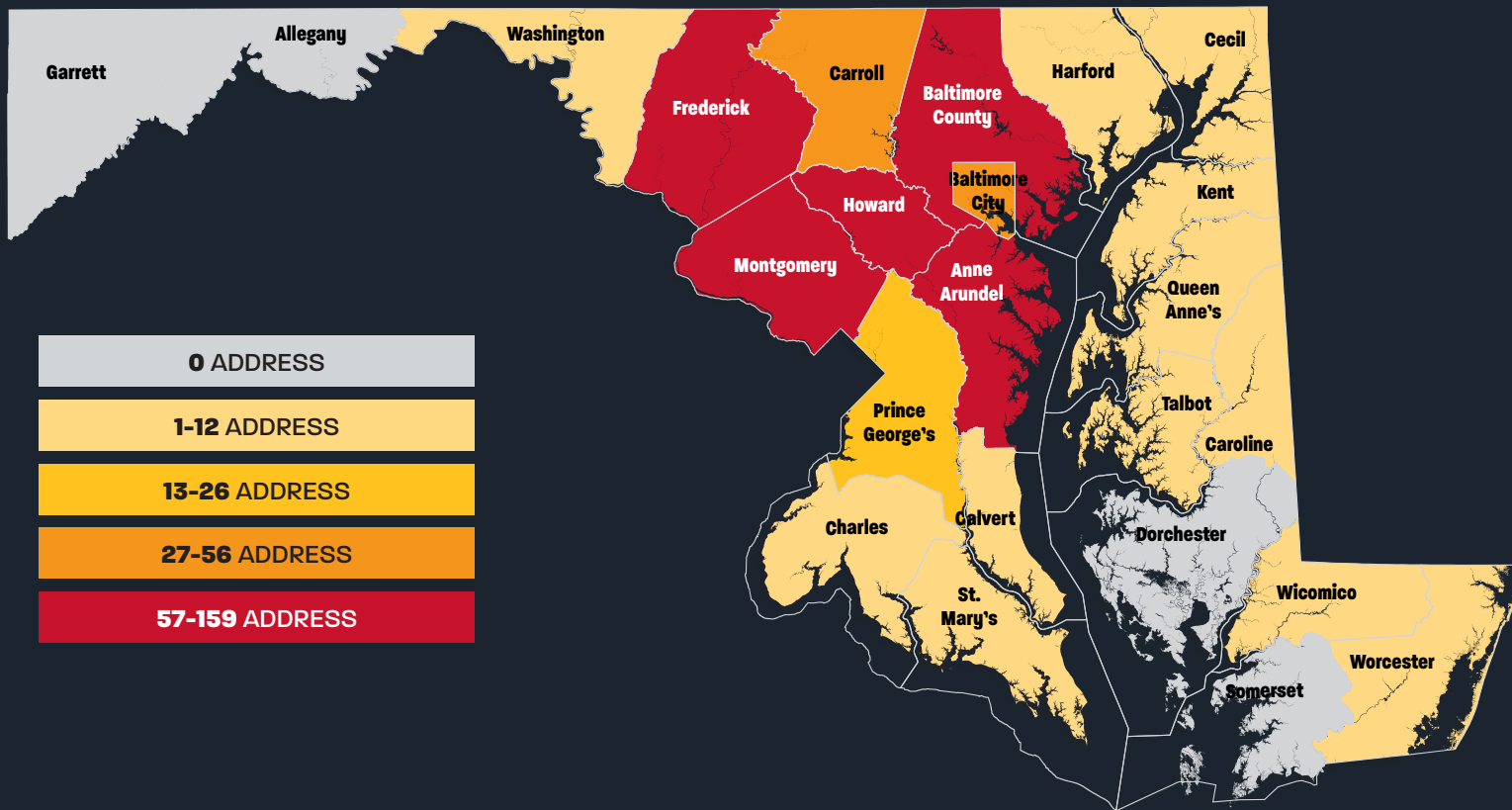
On March 5, 2020, Maryland declared a state of emergency and catastrophic health emergency to control and prevent the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. Temporary emergency measures were enacted that, in part, allowed alcohol manufacturers to sell and deliver their products directly to consumers for off-premises consumption. The Alcoholic Beverages – Manufacturer’s Licenses and Off-Site Permits Act of 2021 established the expiration date of these temporary measures as June 30, 2024.

The Alcoholic Beverages – Breweries, Wineries, and Distilleries – Direct Delivery Act was signed into law in May 2024. This act created a regulatory framework for a Direct Delivery (DD) annual permit that authorizes licensed manufacturers to sell and, using their employees, deliver their own products directly to consumers in Maryland. Direct Delivery permits were first issued in fiscal year 2025.

Permit holders must be aware of and follow limits on the amount of alcohol that can be delivered to an individual address each calendar year. The limit for wine is no more than the equivalent of 18 standard 9-liter cases, including products shipped by the

winery under a Direct Wine Shipper’s permit. The limit for distilled spirits is no more than the equivalent of 24 standard 750 mL bottles, including spirits-based RTDs, regardless of packaging format. The limit for beer is no more than 3,456 ounces, or 288 12-ounce cans, including hard cider and mead.

Direct Delivery permits were issued to 13 manufacturers in FY25. This first fiscal year of active permits saw a total of 1,255 local deliveries of wine and distilled spirits made to 765 addresses throughout Maryland. Of these 765 addresses, 283 (≈37%) received multiple orders from the same permit holder, accounting for 61% of all deliveries. This shows that many recipients have a high level of commitment to their chosen manufacturer. Over 50% of all deliveries were made in Frederick, Howard, and Montgomery counties. There were no deliveries made in Allegany, Dorchester, Garrett, and Somerset counties. The total amount of wine delivered to consumers equaled 4,170 standard 750 mL bottles and the total amount of distilled spirits delivered to consumers amounted to approximately 1,355 standard 750 mL bottles. No beer was delivered under a Direct Delivery permit in FY25.

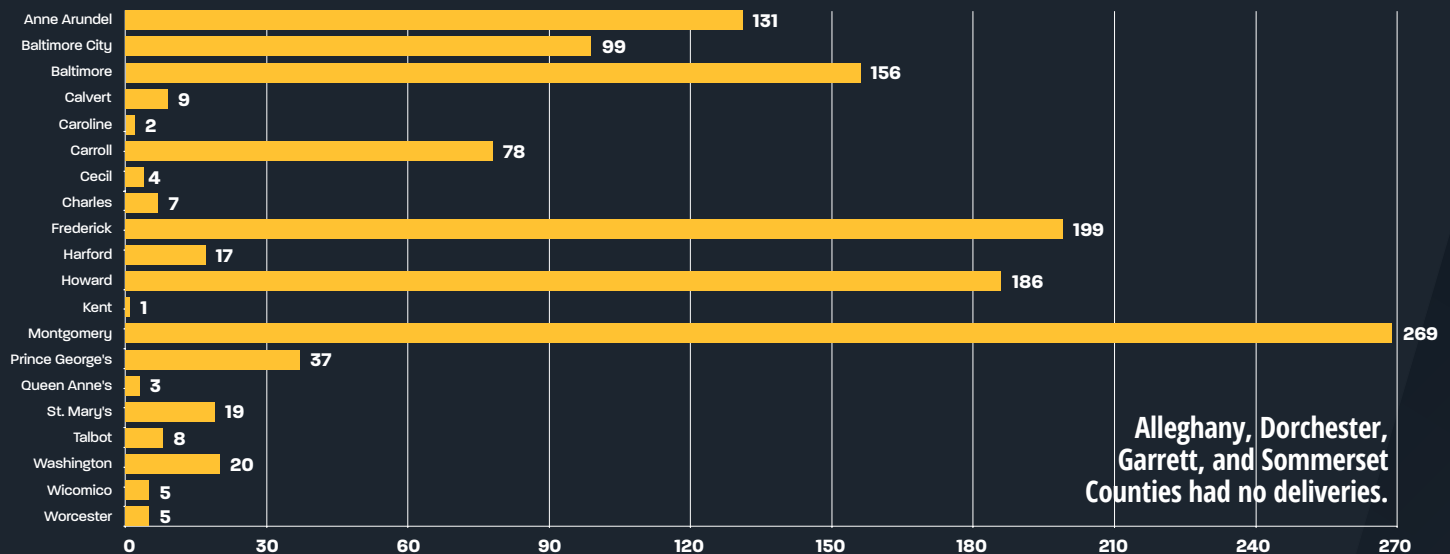

BULK TRANSFER PERMITS

Under Alcoholic Beverages Article §2-111(b), a person whose license has expired or otherwise has been discontinued may, within 60 days, obtain a bulk transfer permit in order to transfer with or without consideration whether by sale, gift, inheritance, assignment or otherwise, the stock of alcoholic beverages on hand as of the last day the license was effective. The fee for a bulk transfer permit is \$200. The table below indicates the number of bulk transfer permits issued in the respective jurisdictions.

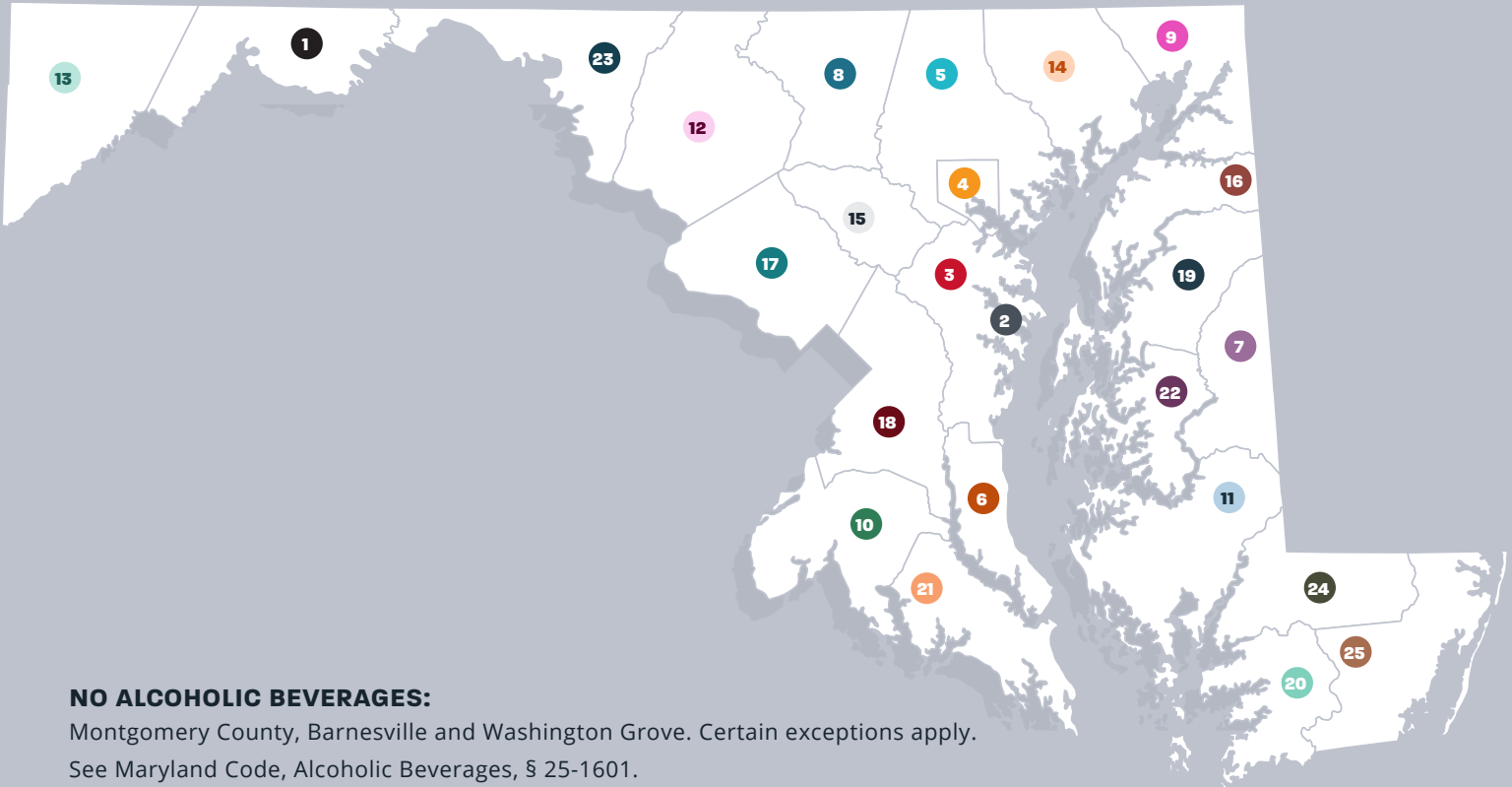
